CALL FOR PAPERS

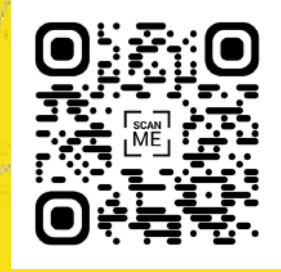
