## SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS, PAPERS AND REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Interested participants are invited to present their papers in either English or Malay. All papers must however be accompanied by an abstract in English with five keywords.

The deadline for submission of abstract is **15 July 2016.** Abstracts must not be more than 250 words, excluding title and contact information. Abstracts should comprise paper title, name of authors (specifying the presenter), name of programme/department, institution, email, fax and telephone numbers. Submitted abstracts should also be accompanied by

a brief biography (100 words) of the presenter including information on current research interests.

Participants whose abstracts are accepted will be notified by 7 August 2016 and full papers should be submitted no later than 1st November 2016.

Papers can be written in either English or Malay using MSWord, Times New Roman, single spaced, font size 12. Paper length should be up to 3000 words, including endnotes and references. Paper writers are requested to use the APA reference style.

Each participant will be required to pay a registration fee of USD 100.00. Student rate is USD50.00.


