FASS Academic Advisor (AA)

Who is the AA?

The AA will be an appointed member of the academic staff for each programme of study in FASS.

Terms of Reference for FASS AAs

- The AA will provide counseling to FASS undergraduate students pertaining to academic related matters, including:
 - Module registration
 - Coursework assignments
 - Class attendance
 - Work performance
 - Graduation matters
- Students with personal issue(s) will be referred to a UBD counselor via the FASS AR.
- Queries about career guidance will be referred to the current appointed FASS career guidance advisors.
- The AA will consult the PL for cases that warrant further attention.

Appointment of AAs

- Each programme will have appointed academic advisors for students at each level of study.
- The PL for each programme will identify the number and name of academic advisor(s) for each level/year of study and submit their names to the Dean.
- The appointment will be for a period of one academic year.
- Students will be notified of their AAs and encouraged to seek help and advice from the relevant AA.
- All academic staff in each programme will be told who the AAs are.
- Students are allowed to see a lecturer other than the assigned AA if they wish.
- All AAs (including lecturers who are not appointed as AAs) will complete an Academic Advisor Report (AAR) after each consultation for record-keeping purposes.

Date of Implementation

The AA appointments will start from Semester 1 2022/2023.
